**Tim Wiedenkeller**, now known to many of his fans as Tim Weed, returns to the Arizona Folklore Preserve for an intimate solo performance on the weekend of April 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>.

Tim is one of the most gifted and versatile musicians to be found anywhere, bringing both charisma and talent to the stage. He started as a teenage prodigy on banjo, touring nationally with a bluegrass band and performing with the likes of Bill Monroe and Ralph Stanley. He spent many years playing guitar

and exploring variety of genres, incorporating exotic music inspired by his world travels. During this time he also began playing banjo with the Maui Symphony Orchestra, and in 2004 he released an acclaimed collection of classical banjo pieces, *Milagros*, which is featured on National Public Radio.

Now a resident of California, Tim just celebrated his 50<sup>th</sup> birthday with a sold-out gala concert in the San Francisco Bay Area. Last year he toured in Germany and was also one of the featured artists and workshop leaders at the California Banjo Gathering (a nationwide gathering that included Pete Seeger). Annually for many years, he has been invited by exhibitors to NAMM, the recording industry's big trade event.

This weekend Tim offers an intimate solo performance. Attendees can expect an eclectic show with songs ranging from Americana and jazz to world music, classical banjo pieces, and a few surprises thrown in.
